

About the Program

This intermediate course intends to provide an overview of fall prevention strategies in the rehabilitation patient. Course includes an opportunity to hear from different organizations on their best practice fall prevention strategies, alternative therapies in fall prevention and building a cohesive interdisciplinary team to focus on fall prevention strategies. Additionally, we will hear from a patient's perspective on recovery after a fall. Nurses will also potentially benefit from networking with other rehabilitation nurses from the area.

Who Should Attend?

Rehabilitation nurses and nurses from other specialties can benefit from this opportunity to fulfill education requirements and advance their careers. In addition, this course is a valuable opportunity for those individuals to expand their knowledge and understanding of the multifaceted world of rehabilitation nursing, and enhance the quality of care provided to these populations of patients.
